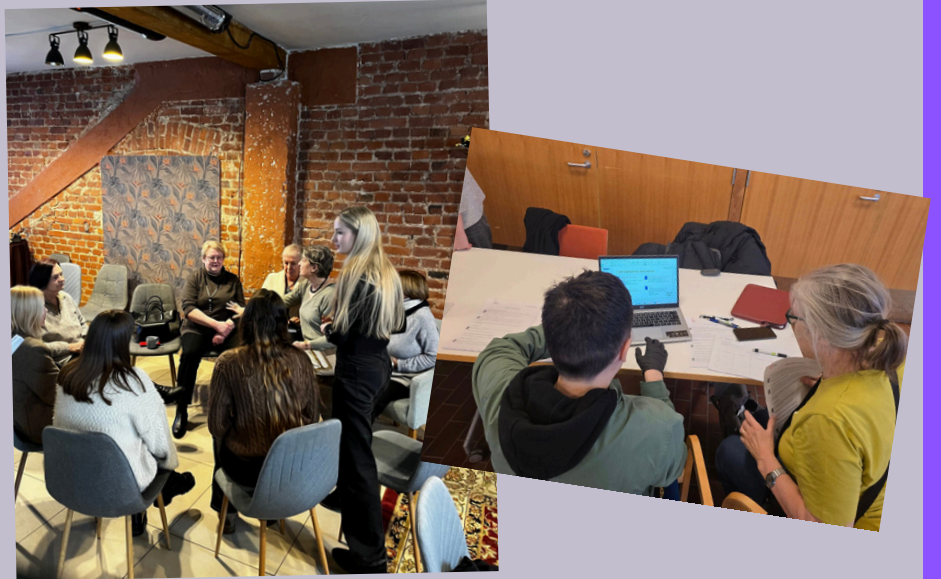

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DIGICulture - Bridging Generations Through Digital Cultural Exploration project youth and senior workshops

DIGICulture - Bridging Generations Through Digital Cultural Exploration (jnr. 36802) is a Nordic Culture Point's Culture and Art 1/2025 programme, funded by the Nordic Council of Ministers. In the project, we train youth to mentor seniors in exploring digital art and culture and in creating some digital art themselves.

Before Christmas, all partners conducted their youth workshops, and during spring 2026 the partners have also implemented their workshops with seniors.

The youth was trained in how to mentor seniors, and partners conducted workshops with more than 15 seniors each, where the youth mentored the seniors in understanding digital cultural tools, e.g. virtual museum tours, concerts, theatre performances, and how to find them online.

They also had discussion sessions with the seniors on how digital technologies have changed since they were young, and experimented in creating some digital art and videos together. Both seniors and youth found the experience rewarding - even though seniors can feel intimidated by technology, having young people helping them made them feel more confident.

Partners also conducted feedback surveys among the youth and presented the results in an online meeting on 25 May. During the summer, all partners will organise a final dissemination event for their networks to share information about the project.
